Students must also pass the Praxis Elementary Education: Content Knowledge (5018) <u>or</u> (effective 9/1/17) the Praxis Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects (5001) <u>or</u> the Reading/Language Arts (5002), Mathematics (5003), Social Studies (5004), and Science (5005) <u>and</u> the Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching: Early Childhood (5621) prior to Student Teaching. **NOTE:** Students must earn at least an overall 2.5 Cumulative GPA and at least a 2.5 Cumulative GPA in all major courses to graduate in this program.
