Instrumental Music Education Footnotes

- ¹ Students with Math ACT scores of 19-20 take MATH 103 and 104
- ² MATH 206 or MATH 210 or STAT 214
- ³ 9 hours of science: 3 hours of Biology and 3 hours from Chemistry, Geology or Physics. 6 of the 9 hours must be in the same science; credit cannot be earned for both GEOL 105 and GEOL 225
- ⁴ HIST 101, 102, 221, or 222
- ⁵ Select 3 Minor Instrument courses: Brass (181), Percussion (183), Strings (185), Woodwinds (187)
- ⁶ Any English or foreign language literature course at or above the 200 level
- ⁷ String majors should see their advisor for a course substitution
- ⁸ Consult with academic advisor. Two semesters of Marching Band are required.

Praxis Exam Requirements: Students must pass the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators: Reading, Writing, and Mathematics or submit an ACT composite score of 22 or higher. Students must also pass the Music: Content Knowledge (5113) and the PLT exam (5622 or 5623 or 5624) prior to Student Teaching.

NOTE: Students must earned at least an overall 2.5 Cumulative GPA and at least a 2.5 Cumulative GPA in all major courses to graduate in this program.
