- <sup>4</sup> HIST 101, 102, 221, or 222
- <sup>5</sup> Select 3 Minor Instrument courses: Brass (181), Percussion (183), Strings (185), Woodwinds (187)
- <sup>6</sup> Any English or foreign language literature course at or above the 200 level
- <sup>7</sup> String majors should see their advisor for a course substitution
- <sup>8</sup> Consult with academic advisor. Two semesters of Marching Band (AMUS 152) are required.

**Praxis Exam Requirements:** Students must pass the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators:Reading, Writing, and Mathematics or submit an ACT composite score of 22 or higher. Students must also pass the Music: Content Knowlesge (5113) and the PLT exam (5622 or 5623 or 5624) prior to Student Teaching. **NOTE**: Students must earn at least an overall 2.5 Cumulative GPA and at least a 2.5 Cumulative GPA in all major courses to graduate in this program.
