### Instrumental Music Education Footnotes

- <sup>1</sup> Students with Math ACT scores of 19-20 take MATH 100
- <sup>2</sup> MATH 206, 210, or STAT 214
- <sup>3</sup> 9 hours of science: 3 hours of Biology and 3 hours from Chemistry, Geology or Physics. 6 of the 9 hours must be in the same science; credit cannot be earned for both GEOL 105 and GEOL 225
- <sup>4</sup> HIST 101, 102, 221, or 222
- <sup>5</sup> Select 3 Minor Instrument courses: Brass (181), Percussion (183), Strings (185), Woodwinds (187)
- <sup>6</sup> Any English or foreign language literature course at or above the 200 level
- <sup>7</sup> String majors should see their advisor for a course substitution
- <sup>8</sup> Consult with academic advisor. Two semesters of Marching Band are required.

**Praxis Exam Requirements:** Students must pass the Praxis I PPST exams (Reading, Writing, Math) or submit an ACT composite score of 22 or higher. Students must also pass the Music content exam, 0113, and the PLT exam 0622 or 623 or 624 prior to Student Teaching.
