Books and Beyond: Igniting, Delighting, and Cultivating Literacy and Literature for Highly Able Students



How do we create classrooms, curriculum, literature experiences that will support highly able students to continue to grow? This intense, fast paced session will focus on the characteristics of highly able language users and strategies to create engaging, rigorous, and relevant literacy instruction that integrates re-

cently published books of all types (graphic novels, picture book biographies, expository texts, novels in verse, and more). The presentation will highlight examples of online tools that support and extend students' engagement and comprehension of text as well as suggest strategies to integrate and escalate reading, writing, speaking, and listening development. Visual vocabulary, found poetry, sketch noting, organizing literary discussions where students are reading different books at different paces, and other strategies to develop and assess comprehension will be shared. Recently published (and maybe some forthcoming not yet published) books will be featured throughout the presentation.

In this session, Dr. Wilson will give real-life and classroom examples of how to build arts integration into all content areas (English/Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, and Math) in deep and meaningful ways through transdisciplinary education.
